

# North State Girls' High School Challenge

Keith Hills CC Buies Creek, NC September 18, 2015



Open Date: August 11 Team Entry Fee: \$50 per player Close Date: September 10

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Open to any public and private girls' high school girls' golf team from North Carolina. Team members must meet age eligibility set by their school. Individual players may enter, but will be put on the alternate list until the closing date and will be accepted if space is available.

### **RULES**

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. PKBGT / TYGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the tournament. Each competitor must walk and carry her own bag during the stipulated round. Push/pull carts are allowed. Caddies will not be permitted. A team may designate one person to act as a coach. That coach is allowed to give advice between the play of two holes, but not during the play of a hole.

### **CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT**

The championship is conducted at 18-holes of team and individual stroke play. Each team may be represented by **four** players and must return three individual 18-hole scores to qualify for the team competition. In case of a tie for the team title, the schools will share the team title. An on-course playoff will be used to determine a tie for the individual medalist. Players are responsible for making themselves available for any playoff they may be part of.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP PRIZES**

Trophies are awarded to the winning school, members of the winning team, medalist and all-tournament first and second teams (5 players each). The all-tournament first team will earn invitations to the PKBGT Invitational at Grandover Resort in Greensboro, NC on November 7-9, 2015.

# **PLAYER EXPECTATIONS**

Each player must be able to play by USGA Rules of Golf and any local rules established by the tournament committee. Each player must be able to walk and carry her own golf bag for each stipulated round they participate in. Pull carts are permitted if allowed by the host club. Each player must be able to play at the pace of play established by the committee for this event. Each player must be able to finish every hole and the total score must be under 120 for 18 holes.

### **ENTRIES**

Each school must complete an official entry form. The first 21 teams entries received will be accepted into the tournament. All other entries will be placed on the alternate list. No entry is accepted prior to the open date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the close date. The PKBGT / TYGA are not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to the coach or the school representing the individual(s) when their status is determined. Status is updated weekly at www.tygajuniorgolf.org. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted. Entries must be returned to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each school or individual and must accompany this form. Make check payable to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association. A check returned for insufficient funds may result in suspension indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.
