## **ABOUT BILL HARVEY**

Bill Harvey left a lasting mark on golf in the Carolinas during his long and distinguished amateur career. Mr. Harvey spent more than 40 years playing tournament golf, amassing more than 300 titles and earning places in both the Carolinas Golf and Guilford County Sports halls of fame. Mr. Harvey won eight CGA championships including three Carolinas Amateur titles (1964, 65, 73), three Carolinas Four-Ball wins (1960, 64, 66), Carolinas Senior Amateur (1990) and the North Carolina Amateur (1966). He also played in 18 U.S. Amateur Championships and won the following tournaments during his career: North Carolina Open, American Amateur Classic, Dixie Amateur, Porter Cup, Dogwood Invitational, National Tournament of Champions (six times) and the Rice Planters (twice). Mr. Harvey also spent a lifetime sharing his love of the game with countless others keeping golf fun for all to enjoy.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Entry is open to any female and male amateur golfer ages 11 to 18 as of October 29, 2017 who has not started college. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the TYGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the TYGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org).

# **REGISTRATION/ENTRIES**

All players must register online at www.tygajuniorgolf.org. Registration for TYGA Members opens on September 18, 2017 at 8 pm. Registration for non-members opens on September 25, 2017 at 8 pm. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. TYGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) may be suspended for one year from all TYGA tournaments.

# **REFUND POLICY**

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Tournament: Full refund minus \$20.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament will receive a full refund.

## **RULES**

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The TYGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

#### **FORMAT**

The tournament format is 36-holes of stroke play.

## **AGE DIVISIONS**

Boys will compete in three age divisions; boys 12-13, boys 14-15 and boys 16-18. Girls will compete in one division.

# **YARDAGES**

Champions course

Boys 14-15 & 16-18 will play from white tee - 6,580 yards, par 72. Boys 11-13 and all girls will play from mix of gold and red tees 5,600 yards, par 72.

Players course

Boys 14-15 & 16-18 will play from white tee - 6,516 yards, par 72. Boys 11-13 and all girls will play from mix of gold and red tees 5,600 yards, par 72.

#### <u>PRIZES</u>

Trophies are awarded to the overall champion and the top five places in each division.

## **ACCEPTANCE**

Players gain entry on a first come first serve basis. Field is limited to 105 players (75 boys and 30 girls).
