High School Invitational\*, 2018 TYGA Pinecrest HS Invitational\*, 2018 TYGA Bojangles, 2018 TYGA Coastal Plains, 2018 TYGA High Point Jr, 2018 Roy Jones Jr, 2018 SAS Junior, and all division winners from each TYGA One-Day and TYGA Triad One-Day series events between August 10, 2017 and August 14, 2018.

All entrants must register on line through the MyCGA registration system. Registration will be open until 11:59 p.m. of the close date or until the field is full (84 players). **Confirmation of acceptance will be sent via e-mail only and posted at [www.tygajuniorgolf.org](http://www.tygajuniorgolf.org).** A \$20 administrative fee will charged to all withdrawals. No refunds will be given after entries close. TYGA is not responsible for error and/or delays with any internet service.

Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the tournament, by the Carolinas Golf Association, the Tarheel Youth Golf Association, or the host club. The reason may include unbecoming conduct. Players failing to show without either notifying the TYGA office or the host site prior to the event may be subject to suspension from future events.

Each competitor must walk and carry his or her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 or younger (no exceptions) and must walk. Divisions will be as follows: Boys' Overall (14-18), Boys' 14-15, Boys' 16-18, Boys' 12-13, Boys' 11 and Under (9 holes only), Girls' Overall (14-18), Girls' 12-13, Girls' Under 11 (9 holes only). TYGA reserves the right to adjust divisions based on the size of field. Tee time assignments will be posted on **August 10th** on the [www.tygajuniorgolf.org](http://www.tygajuniorgolf.org). Cell phones and tobacco products are prohibited. USGA Rules of Golf govern all competitions. Local rules will be distributed at the event.
