Prizes:	Trophies will be awarded to the top five in each division.							
	An on course playoff will be used to determine a tie for the championship.							
	All other ties will be broken by the USGA method of matching cards.							
Caddies:	Caddies will not be allowed.							
Measuring devices:	Devices that measure distance may be used during this championship.							
Pull carts:	Competitors are allowed to use pull/push carts.							
Spectator carts:	Spectator carts will be available at a rate of \$20 per cart. All spectator carts must remain on the cart path at all times.							
Payment Methods:	Colonial CC accepts cash, Visa and MasterCard for all purchases.							
Rankings:	This is a TYGA N.C. rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 5.							
Parent policy:	Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.							
Withdraws:	If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event online or by contacting the CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to October 13. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you may be suspended from CGA/TYGA events for 1 year.
