Format: Team and individual 18-hole stroke play. The low 4 scores will be used for the team score.

Practice round: Please call club for availability and rate.

Yardage: All play will be from Blue tees – 6,322 yards, par 72 (69.8/122)

Starting times: 2:00 pm shotgun start. Pairings will be available through the tygajuniorgolf.org web site on March 27, 2019.

Prizes: Trophies are awarded to the winning school, members of the winning team, medalist and

all-tournament first and second teams (5 players each).

Ties: A tie for the team title will be broken by team's fifth individual score. If the fifth individual scores are the

same, the school will share the team title. A tie for the medalist award will be shared by the tied players.

Caddies: Players must walk and carry their own bag at all times. Push/pull carts are allowed.

Caddies will not be allowed.

Spectator carts: Spectator will be available at a rate of \$25 per cart. Spectator carts are rented on a first come first served

basis.

Coach's registration: Coaches are required to check in with the tournament committee to receive their identification arm band.

Coach's advice: Each team may designate 1 individual to serve as their coach. Coaches may give advice to their players

only between the play of two holes.

Rankings: This is a TYGA N.C. rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 2.

Team rosters: Final rosters are due by March 25, 2019.

Optimist Junior The top three in the boys' 16-18 division and the top player in the boys' 14-15 division players will earn

invitations to the Optimist International Junior Championship at Trump National Doral Resort in Miami, FL in

July, 2019. All players are automatically entered into the qualifier at no additional cost.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no

cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office

at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you

may be suspended from TYGA / CGA events for 1 year.
