ELIGIBILITY

Open to any public and private North Carolina high school golf team. Team members must meet age eligibility set by their school.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. NCJGF/ TYGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the tournament. Use of tobacco products by competitors is prohibited. Each competitor must walk and carry his or her own bag during the stipulated round. Caddies will not be permitted. A team may designate one person to act as a coach. That coach is allowed to give advice between the play of two holes, but not during the play of a hole.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 36-holes of team and individual stroke play. Each team may be represented by **five** players and must return four individual 18-hole scores each day to qualify for the team championship. In case of a tie for the team championship, the fifth individual score from round two will be used to break the tie. If the fifth individual scores from round two are the same, the fifth individual scores from round one will be used to break the tie. If the fifth individual's scores are the same on both days, the schools will share the championship team title. An on-course playoff will be used to determine a tie for the individual medalist. Players are responsible for making themselves available for any playoff they may be part of.

CHAMPIONSHIP PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the winning school, members of the winning team, medalist and all-tournament first and second teams (5 players each).

ENTRIES

Each school must complete an official entry form. The first 18 teams entries received will be accepted into the tournament. Spots will be held for the top three teams from 2015 (Cannon School, Pinecrest HS and Myers Park HS) and host site school (Concord HS) until February 29, 2016. All other entries will be placed on the alternate list. No entry is accepted prior to the open date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the close date. The NCJGF/TYGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to the coach or the school representing the individual(s) when their status is determined. Status is updated weekly at www.tygajuniorgolf.org. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted. Entries must be returned to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association, 140 Ridge Road, Southern Pines, NC 27376. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each school or individual and must accompany this form. Make check payable to the Tarheel Youth Golf Association. A check returned for insufficient funds may result in suspension indefinitely from TYGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close. A \$50 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.
