

2016 TYGA Tournament of Champions Maple Chase Golf & GC Winston-Salem, NC August 16-17, 2016



Tournament Players

Format: 36-hole stroke play (11 and under will play modified stableford points, 9 holes each day)

Practice round: A practice round (\$20 walking rate) will be available at Maple Chase CC on August 15. Contestants

must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Players may call up to 7 days in advance to schedule a practice round. Please identify yourself as a TYGA Tournament of

Champions when calling.

Starting times: Starting times will be available through the TYGA/CGA office and/or the tygajuniorgolf.org web site

on **August 8, 2016**. <u>Please do not call before this date</u>. Starting will be in the morning on both days. Players are asked to check in with the starter 10 minutes before their starting time. Round 2 Starting

Times will be based on Round 1 scores. It will be a morning time.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the overall champions and the winner, runner-up and second runner-up

in each division.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no

exceptions, this includes the 11 and under division. Penalty is disqualification.

Range finders: Range finders may be used during the championship.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per cart. Carts must remain on paths at all

times.

Pull carts: Maple Chase CC does allow pull carts and they may be used during the tournament.

Dress code: Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward; males must remove hat/visor while indoors.

Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path

(roughs in no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the

TYGA/CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are

considered a "no show" and you will be suspended from CGA and TYGA events for 1 year.
