### ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male or female amateur golfer ages 12-18 as of August 10, 2017 and who has not started college. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the TYGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website ([www.carolinagolf.org](http://www.carolinagolf.org)).

### ENTRIES

All players must register online at [www.tygajuniorgolf.org](http://www.tygajuniorgolf.org). TYGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any Internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is emailed to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at [www.tygajuniorgolf.org](http://www.tygajuniorgolf.org). TYGA members received a \$15 discount.

### FIELD SIZE

Field is limited to 105 participants.

### ACCEPTANCE

Priority is given to junior residents from Wake County or any county adjacent to Wake (Franklin, Granville, Durham, Chatham, Harnett, Johnston or Nash) on a first come first serve basis. If field is not full (105), then juniors from outside of counties listed above are accepted on a first come first serve basis.

### RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

### REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day before tournament: Full refund minus \$20.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day of event: No refund for any reason.

### AGE DIVISIONS

Boys will compete one of in three divisions (12-13, 14-15 and 16-18) and girls will compete in one of two age divisions (12-13 and 14-18) based on their age as of August 10, 2017. TYGA reserves the right to adjust age divisions based on the number of players registered to compete.

### FORMAT

18-holes of stroke play.

### SAS Junior Club Championship

The SAS Junior Club Championship competition is held in conjunction with the tournament. Teams of three or four competitors from the same club comprise a team. The low three scores count each round. TYGA will contact clubs with more than four eligible players to select their team roster. Otherwise, TYGA will select players with the four lowest USGA Handicap Indexes. Team rosters are due to the TYGA by August 7, 2017.

### YARDAGES

Boys' 14-15 and 16-18 will compete from blue tees (6,500 yards, par 72). Boys' 12-13 and all girls' will compete from green tees (5,550 yards, par 72).

### PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the top three places in each division. SAS Junior Club Championship trophy is presented to the winning team to be displayed at their club.
